Security have set procedures for dealing with someone displaying a fever temperature. Those who have a locker in B-Fab can also be tested by an additional more accurate thermal camera, all staff are aware of the protocol to follow if a high temperature alarm is triggered. Good ventilation (i.e. keeping the windows open) and facing away from each other may help to reduce the risk of transmission. Private vehicles that are used by people from multiple households should be cleaned regularly using gloves and standard cleaning products with particular emphasis on handles and other areas where passengers may touch surfaces.'
